JYSI (Justice for Youth Survivors Initiative) is a new, youth-led initiative that works with young people to end the punishment and criminalization of girls and gender-expansive youth who are survivors of sexual assault and abuse.

WHAT DO YOUTH ADVISORS DO?



Youth advisors participate in training and engage in research activities focused on survivor experiences with the criminal legal system and survivor support needs. This research will contribute to the creation of JYSI's resources and raise public awareness of this critical issue impacting girls and gender-expansive youth.



Youth Advisors commit to attending monthly 90-minute meetings over the course of a year, starting with an orientation in June 2024. Advisors will engage in research activities in collaboration with peers and council members to advance JYSI's mission.
